

- c. Recommend the terms of reference and selection of Independent Private Operator of "Cardiac Registry of Pakistan" and regulate its operations.
- d. Recommend the medical devices of acceptable quality for use by Cath Labs including issuance of negative list of devices.
- e. Frame rules where necessary and form committees to carry out any specific functions including but not limited to Peer Committees to evaluate complaints.


Cardiac Registry of Pakistan (CROP)

1. The Cardiac Registry of Pakistan (similar to the National Cardiovascular Data Registry operated by the American College of Cardiology) has already been designed and setup as an initiative by PSIC member interventional cardiologists and is being currently operated under the guidance of the PSIC and is being participated in on a trial basis by 16 leading Cath Labs. Through the capture and reporting of reliable patient and procedure data CROP provides participants the tools to measure, benchmark and improve interventional cardiology processes and patient care. The NICB shall adopt and take ownership of CROP, which shall be thereafter handed over to a selected and secure private entity for its operations to ensure neutrality and security of the data and registry.
2. The operations and utilization of CROP shall be defined pursuant to the CROP Terms & Conditions to be framed jointly by the NICB and PSIC. The objective would be to further provide a secured data base retaining patient and facility confidentiality and protecting intellectual property rights of each facility while simultaneously development of a resource to set improved benchmarks of processes and patient care as well as resource to respond to complaints and peer reviews.

Public Information

1. Information as to the lists of accredited Interventional Cardiologists, accredited and registered Cath Labs, approved LSMD's, pricing of approved

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5. DRAP shall at the earliest setup and make operational the National Medical Device Registry (NMDR) in consultation with the NICB and PSIC and the relevant device importers association.
 6. All Provincial Healthcare Commissions to require as a condition of registration all Cath Labs to register with CROP.
 7. Provincial Healthcare Commissions to ensure that the Certification Criteria for Interventional Cardiologists along with cath lab registration/regulation criteria, as per the CCL Guidelines 2017 be enforced.
 8. Lists of accredited Cath Labs, accredited Interventional Cardiologists, approved LSMD's and prices of approved LSMD's be available on the websites of PSIC, DRAP, all Provincial Healthcare Facilities including a central link to submit complaints to the NICB in terms of pricing, services and procedures with such complaints simultaneously being also brought to the knowledge of the relevant Provincial Healthcare Commission and DRAP.
2. Having considered the report, we make it a part of this order. We direct that the above report be implemented in letter and spirit within a period of 90 days by all concerned quarters including but not limited to public and private hospitals, importers, distributors and sellers of cardiac stents and other related components, interventional cardiologists and all other departments, regulators and supervisory bodies / societies / bodies / agencies / departments having any direct, indirect or incidental nexus or connection with the import, sale, distribution, embedding, etc of cardiac stents and matters connected therewith. Compliance reports by all concerned be submitted after the lapse of stipulated period of 90 days for our perusal in Chambers.

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
